He also committed to provide a new borehole to provide water to New House and the New Dining Hall and he will also provide a brand new 22-33 KVA generator to service New House.

6. GCUOBA Global/ N400 million Challenge & Wall of Honour Campaign

A Townhall meeting was held on the 6th of March 2021 to enlighten our Old Boys especially the Pre-Civil War Old Boys (classes up to 1967) about the restoration project and inform them of our goal to raise up to N400M towards the restoration project to build essential sites for the reopening of the school such as the Principals house, staff quarters, science laboratory, the fence and the assembly hall.

The FEDT developed a campaign to honour our GCUOBA Global donors towards the adoption of the legacy projects called the 'N400 million challenge & Wall of Honour Campaign' as the goal is to raise a total sum of N400 million from this group of Old Boys and each donor will be honoured on a wall of Honour that will be displayed in a prominent location at the new GCU.
